



Guess That Fish!



FISH #1

- I have a dark blue stripe on the top of my body
- My ventral fin looks like a fish hook
- I have a blue dorsal fin

FISH #2

- I have a very long and thin body
- I have a small pectoral fin
- I have a very long dorsal fin that stretches all the way down my back
- I have a narrow pelvic fin

FISH #3

- My name means pretty in spanish
- I have stripes running down my body
- I have small dorsal fins (finlets)

FISH #4

- I am a flat fish
- I have one long dorsal fin
- I am camouflaged to look like sand

Fish #5

- I have three dorsal fins
- The first of my three dorsal fins is triangle shaped
- I have a barbel! (a fish beard)

FISH #6

- My first dorsal fin is short and spiny
- My caudal fin is dark blue at the tip
- I am blue and silver in color

FISH #7

- My dorsal fin looks like a fan
- I have a large mouth
- I have large gills
- I get my name from the stripes on my body

FISH #8

- I have three brown dorsal fins
- I have speckled scales that look a bit like leopard spots
- I have two ventral fins
